Scotland Highlands Malts

Sweeter and carrying more body than those from the Lowlands, they tend to have a dry, fragrant fruity-sweet flavour together with a touch of smokiness.

Glenmorangie 10yrs 40% £11.00

Called the original, it's the marriage of delicate spirit and long slow maturation. Spicy with some flowery sweetness.

Glenmorangie 18yrs 43% £20.00

Very soft with hints of malt and slightly spicy touches from the extra maturation in used Bourbon barrels.

Oban 14yrs 43% £13.00

A great, well balanced blend of spice, smoke, perfume and sweetness. One of the best whisky from the Western Highlands.

Dalmore 15yrs 40% £14.00

Rich red mahogany. Fine structure of sweet vanilla with aromatic cloves, cinnamon and ginger. Seville oranges, lemons and limes, aged in sherry casks.

Dalmore King Alexander III 40% £30.00

Crushed almonds and rich citrus fruits. Port, Marsala, wild berries and fleshy plums. Warm vanilla notes of creamy toffee with ripe red fruits. Aged in vintage Oloroso and Madeira butts, vintage Bourbon barrels, Cabernet Sauvignon barriques.

Lowlands Malts

Lowland Malt Whiskies tend to be light, fresh and aromatic and are ideal as an aperitif

Auchentoshan 12yrs 40% £13.00

The only Malt Whisky Distillery in Glasgow, it is clean and fresh with hints of citrus and vanilla. Perfect whisky aperitif that pings around the palate.

Auchentoshan Three Wood 43% £14.50

Richly textured, aged in 3 types of wood to give extra complexity. This is a seriously critically acclaimed Malt that we highly recommend.

Glenkinchie 43% £15.50
Glenkinchie single malt has a warm finish, dry with a smoky spiciness.

Speyside Malts

Speyside whiskies tend to be rich in flavour and complexity and have fruity, leafy and honeyed notes.

Balvenie Double Wood 12 yrs 40% £12.50
It has been transferred from a traditional oak whisky cask to a first fill Spanish oak sherry cask. Sweet fruit and oloroso sherry notes, layered with honey and vanilla.

Glenfiddich 18yrs 40% £19.00
Mainly notes of spiced apples and robust oak. Great mellowness and oaky dryness quality Speysider.

Glenfiddich 30yrs 43% £45.00
Plenty of wood spicy notes from this well respected Distillery.
Glenfiddich whiskies are known for its fullness of flavour and subtle nuances.

The Macallan 10yrs 40% £11.00
Even though young, it brings up deep aromas of butterscotch and honey.

The Macallan 18yrs 40% £25.00
General opinion with Whisky fans is that the 18 year old is top class.
Rich stewed fruit and mellow flavours makes this a classic.

Cragganmore 12yrs 40% £15.00
Single Speyside malt, an elegant and sophisticated speyside with the most complex aroma of any malt. Astonishingly fragrant with sweetish notes and a smoky maltiness on the finish.

Glenfarclas 15yrs 46% £13.00
Whisky enthusiasts say this age demonstrates all the complexity of this malt.
Assertive.

Campbeltown Malts

Somewhere between the Lowlands and the Highlands when it comes to dryness.
Lightly Smoky, with a salty aftertaste.

Springbank 15yrs 46% £18.00
Sweetness and greenness touches with a good creamy oak flavour.
Smooth, malt finish and saltiness on the tail.

Springbank 21yrs 46% £80.00
The Classic Springbank. Creamy with a salty tongue but smooth as silk.
Suggestions of coconut and brine. This is sensational, very rare
and hard to find. Recommended.

The Island Malts

Singular in character due to the seaweedy atmosphere that permeates the soil
and warehouses, making it the boldest of malts.

Talisker 10yrs (Skye) 45.8% £12.00
Particular on its own. Pungent and smoked-accented to the nose
developing pepperiness to the palate and long finish.

Islay Malts

The most pungent and most heavily peated,
Islay is home to the country's most distinctive group of malts.

Lagavulin 16yrs 43% £19.00
Peaty, oily and powerful complex finish. Smoky and almost burnt character.

Laphroaig 10yrs 43% £10.50
The color is gold with greenish glints, the nose is full and marked by peat
red fruit liquorice, menthol and animal hints.

Laphroaig 15yrs 43% £12.00
The succulent elder brother of the robust 10yrs old.
Mildly smoky, medium to full bodied with sweet undertones.

Ardberg Uigeadail (pronounced Oog-a-dal) 54.2 % £ 11.00
Intensely smoky. Dry, clean, tangy smoke. Like standing downwind of the barbecue while steaks are char-grilled on the beach.

Bowmore 18yrs 43% £19.50
Autumn leaves on a damp woodland floor. Intensely floral with citrus and chocolate tones on the palate. Complex and beautifully balanced. A wonderful dream from the Islay's oldest distillery.

Bowmore 25yrs 43% £50.00
A slightly perfumed, dark, peaty, smokiness and a touch of oak tannin. Blended herbs sherry and a peat in the mouth, with a long deep finish. Voted "Best in the World" at the International Spirits Challenge in San Francisco. A truly magnificent whisky.

Blended Scotch Whisky

They truly represent the Art of the Master Distiller.

Chivas Regal 12yrs 40% £9.95
Blended Scotch whisky with fruity aroma and smooth fragrance.

Chivas Royal Salute 21yrs 40% £29.00
Full bodied with a subtle depth of fragrance flavours.

Japanese

Masataka Taketsuru came to Scotland back in 1918 to learn the art of distilling. Yamazaki was the first Japanese Distillery to produce Whisky in 1923. Today Japan produces high-quality brands good enough to rival classic Scottish malts.

Yamazaki 12yrs 40% £14.00

Fresh and clean aroma delicately spiced with cinnamon and vanilla. The taste is crispy with a nutty, woody flavour and a soothing finish abundant in tropical fruits.

Hibiki 17yrs 43% £23.00

Light citrus floral notes with fresh vanilla aromas coming through. Rich and round on the palate with a creamy finish, top class award winning blend of flavours.

Hakushu 12yrs 43.5% £14.00

Hints of caramel well balanced with smoke and spice, long and dry finish.

Irish

They are one of the oldest forms of Whisky, which was largely consumed during the Victorian times. The lengthy aging process of Irish Whisky makes sure that the Whisky becomes extremely smooth and easy to savor.

Bushmills 10yrs 40% £8.00

Triple distilled in traditional copper pot stills, Bushmills is very delicate and fruity. The classic aperitif whisky

Jameson 40% £8.50

Triple distilled, Jameson has a mellow sweetness balanced with fresh and floral notes.

Welsh

Penderyn 46% £9.00

This Welsh Whisky is rare and precious. Powerful on the palate with a mellowness of Madeira.

Cognac

The best known and most famous of the world's brandies.

Martell

Founded in 1715 by Jean Martell from Jersey, who married daughters of two Cognac merchants. His second wife, Rachel Lallemant, took over the running of the business after his death and Martell remains run, albeit now owned, by the Firino family, who married into Martell during the 19th century.

VSOP 40% £10.50
The Martell V.S.O.P. is a skilful blend of grapes from the Grande and Petit Champagne areas, which provide energy, finesse and length. Of golden amber colour, presents a light aroma of the grape, some wood and a touch of vanilla.

XO 40% £24.00
Complex, full of flavour. Hints of almond and vanilla. A powerful Cognac with a long and pleasant aftertaste.

Remy Martin

Founded in 1724, Remy Martin produces Cognacs only using grapes from the two premiers crus, Grande and Petite Champagne. The wine is double distilled on the lees in small stills and aged in small oak casks from the nearby Limousin forest.

XO 40% £24.00
A Fine Champagne Cognac (20% from Petite Champagne and 80% Grande Champagne), very smooth with candied fruit, marmalade and figs plus a cinnamon spice edge.
Extra Old Cognac - uses three decades of Cognac which contain eaux-de-vie from 8-35 years of age.

LOUIS XIII 40% £135.00
A unique 100% Grande Champagne Cognac, with a minimum ageing of 80 years. Exclusive quality with notes of jasmine, very old tawny port, saffron, nutmeg and passion fruit.

Hennessy

Richard Hennessy joined an Irish regiment fighting under Louis XV when he was 26 years old and after being garrisoned in the Charente region decided to establish himself in Cognac. In 1765 he became a dealer in eaux-de-vie and founded the Hennessy firm, shipping Cognac to British aristocrats.

XO 40% £24.00

Composed of over 100 eaux-de-vie from the Grande and Petite Champagne, Borderies and Fins Bois regions.

Powerful, masculine and generous – a genuine pleasure, extremely smooth, mellow on the palate with hints of spice and pepper, oak, ripe fruit, old leather and floral notes.

PARADIS 40% £58.00

One of Hennessy's best kept secrets. This is the product of successive blends of several hundred eaux-de-vie. The aromas and flavours are the ultimate delight for the senses. The palate is exceptionally rich and smooth, but complex, with pronounced floral herbaceous notes and light vanilla spice.

RICHARD 40% £155.00

Blended from at least one hundred of Hennessy's Cognac reserves, some dating from the 1800s. Well rounded, mature and at the same time ever youthful. Extremely elegant Cognac.

ELLIPSE 43% £695.00

A perfect time machine. It highlights the genius of seven generations of master blenders dating back to 1800. Candied fruits, wild roses, earthy aroma that comes from aging. Great age and elegance.

Courvoisier

Founded by Emmanuel Courvoisier and Louis Gallois in the early 19th century, this Cognac house supplied the imperial courts of Napoleon I, II and III. In 1909 an English family, the Simmons, bought the company, adopted the slogan “the Brandy of Napoleon”. Allied Domecq took over the company in the mid 1970s.

XO IMPERIAL 40% £24.00

A blend of Grande Champagne, Petite Champagne and Borderies aged between 20 and 25 years. Intensely aromatic, incredibly smooth and honeyed with hints of cinnamon, dark chocolate, vanilla, orange, dried apricots and pear.

ESPRIT 40% £455.00

Launched in 2000, only two thousand individually numbered Lalique crystal decanters containing this rare Cognac were produced. This is liquid history a blend of Grande Champagne and Borderies from the rarest, oldest and finest Cognacs, dating from the Napoleon era to the twentieth century.

Meukow

NECTAR 40% £300.00

Is the pure heritage of the very long experience of Meukow Cognac celebrating its oldest eaux-de-vie.

La Pouyade

This premium brand has been produced and owned by the Bouyer family for 14 generations. Only one blend is produced, a 100% Grande Champagne made exclusively from Folle Blanche grapes, with a minimum age of 80 years old. The family have owned oak forest for several generations and the barrels are produced from the hearts of trees no younger than 150 years old which grow in the Tronçais area of the Limousin region.
